**Sub: Preliminary scrutiny and verification of project proposals
And potential beneficiaries of REGP-reg.**

The Secretary SSI & ARI, Govt. of India, New Delhi visited Gorakhpur and observed that more care was necessary to ensure proper selection of beneficiaries. During the Central Zone Review meeting on REGP conducted by the Commissioner for KVI on 24th June, 2006 at Bhopal, the issue of preliminary scrutiny and verification of project proposals as well as screening of potential beneficiaries under REGP was discussed and it was decided that efforts should be made to ensure that weaker sections and un-employed rural youth/persons get benefit of the scheme.

Keeping this objective in view, it has been decided that field offices of KVIC and KVIBs will conduct preliminary scrutiny of the project proposals and profiles of potential beneficiaries relating to his/her background, social category, fulfillment of REGP norms etc. before sponsoring the proposal to Banks. This would also include physical verification of the project site to ensure that old / existing units are not taken under the fold of REGP. Preference should be given to applicants belonging to weaker section and rural un-employed so that purpose of the REGP scheme is fulfilled.
